

Airspeed High Ultralights Pilot Permit Checklist

- Age Requirements**
Students must be 14 years of age to obtain Student Pilot Permit, 16 for the Ultralight Pilot Permit and 18 for the Instructor Rating.
- Medical Certificate**
Min Category 4 self declared submitted by student, No Fee
- Ground School**
Minimum 20 hrs and must be Transport Canada certified.
- Radio Operator Certificate (Self Study)**
Written Exam from Industry Canada administered by Airspeed High (Minimum grade 70%, 25 questions)
- Flight Instruction**
Minimum total 10 hrs, typical 20-25 hrs
Minimum 5 hrs Dual, 2 hrs Solo
Must include 30 takeoffs and landings with no less than 10 takeoffs and landings solo.
- Transport Canada ULTRA Exam**
Minimum 5 hrs flight time required to write exam
Must be written within 60 days of completing ground school at a Transport Canada office or delegate
Minimum grade 60%
- Pre-Solo Exam**
Administered by Airspeed High (Minimum grade 90%, 50 questions)
- Student Pilot Permit**
Issued at Airspeed High Ultralights, No fee
- Flight Test**
Administered by Airspeed High Ultralights.
- Pilot Permit Application**
Complete permit application
Complete aviation booklet application (2 passport photos required)
Pay fee to Transport Canada
- Receive Ultralight Pilot Permit**
